- A simple project with profound results. The results of this project, after just one meeting, are profound. The women who attend have an immediate desire to learn more, share the things they learn with their children, and influence within their sphere of influence.
- A heart changing program that is creating pockets of liberty in homes all over America. The Cottage Meeting Project can be a powerful, sustaining force in building a nation of well-informed citizens through the mothers of America and lead to a people capable of sustaining freedom.

Cottage Meeting Project A Simple Project with Profound Result



What is a Cottage Meeting? The Cottage Meeting Project is Tupperware for Liberty a revolutionary idea based on a familiar model—home parties. *The message of the Cottage Meetings* is that liberty is crucial to a happy, purposeful, prosperous life and that only self-governing individuals can be worthy of and give life to the American system of government built to preserve such liberty.

Why a Cottage Meeting? Two reasons. First, *no organization is doing what we're doing*. Second, *relationships*. The Cottage Meeting brings moms together with just the right amount of structure (not too much and not too little) to help them feel empowered to first know and understand the principles of liberty.

How do moms host a Cottage Meeting? Once a mother decides she's in, MFA provides her with our Resource Guide consisting of 12 simple lessons with thought provoking discussion questions, short stories and short reads to provide a framework for studying liberty and breaking it down in a way that makes sense and is applicable.

Do Cottage Meetings work? As Cottage Meetings have formed and grown over the past four years, hearts and homes changed. Our evidence shows that after participating in just one Cottage Meeting, mothers feel enlightened and empowered. Some mothers immediately share what they've learned with their children and husband over dinner that night. Others tell their friends and family. Mothers who wanted nothing to do with politics suddenly become active citizens in their communities. Other moms who rarely or blindly voted suddenly become engaged, informed voters or help on a campaign, or start a book club, or organize their own Cottage Meeting.

Today there are 130 Cottage Meetings running in 23 states. Average attendance is between 7-9, but one is hosting between 50-80 women. Properly funded, MFA seeks to increase the number of Cottage Meetings to 500 regular meetings, hosting nearly 2,500 to 4,500 moms by the end of 2021.
